- New construction and replacement of toilets installed after 1993 do not qualify.
- Toilet installation must be within the CWASD service area and served by an open and active potable water service account.
- Rebate will cover the cost of the toilet, up to a maximum of \$150.
- Replacement toilet must meet EPA WaterSense standards.
- Application must be postmarked within 90 days of purchase.
- A separate application must be submitted for each metered address.

The undersigned expressly agrees that COACHELLA WATER AUTHORITY & SANITARY DISTRICT (CWASD) may inspect all properties participating in the Toilet Replacement Rebate Program; that CWASD does not guarantee the performance of any toilet; and that CWASD does not warrant any toilet or installation to be free of defects; the quality of workmanship, or the suitability of the premises or the toilet for the installation.
